### **TRANSITION WEEK**



### **SUMMER READING CHALLENGE**

**Story Garden** is this year's Summer Reading Challenge, which will be taking place in all Barking and Dagenham Libraries (and throughout the UK) over the summer holidays.

The challenge is for children aged 4-11 to sign up to **Story Garden** at their local library and read at least six books over the holidays. They will receive a special collector's folder and small prizes along the way, then a certificate and medal when they complete the challenge. There is also a special mini- challenge for children under 4 with their own certificate when they finish.





### **SCHOOL UNIFORM**


