

Attendance and punctuality

This is Simon.

He is in Year 2 and has 90% attendance.

Is that good?



Good attendance means...

being in school at least 95% of the time - that's 180 to 190 days

1.

1 school year at 90% attendance = 4 weeks of lessons missed!

5 school years at 90% attendance = half a year of lessons missed! That's a lot of lost education and a BIG GAP between your child and their peers



Attendance

- Rewards
- Holidays in term time (fines)





- 5 minutes late every day
- = 3 days missed opportunities
- 10 minutes late every day
- = 6 days missed opportunities

Water bottles


- Access to water
- · Water bottles provided by school
- · Water bottles from home
 - ✓ clear/transparent (not coloured)
 - ✓ not single-use plastic
 - ✓ contains only plain, still water (unless there is a medical reason that has been agreed through a health plan).



Water bottles that do not comply with the above will be sent home and the child will use their school water bottle instead.


How can you help your child?

- Talk to them about Year 1 over the summer holiday:
 - -read to them daily eg: before they go to sleep
 - -join the library summer reading scheme
 - -once a week, go over their phonics and Year 1 words (so that they are not at a disadvantage next term)
