Water

- Access to water
- Water bottles provided by school
- Water bottles from home
 - ✓ clear/transparent (not coloured)
 - ✓ not single-use plastic
 - ✓ contains only plain, still water (unless there is a medical reason that has been agreed through a health plan).



Water bottles that do not comply with the above will be sent home and the child will use their school water bottle instead.

Good attendance means...

being in school at least 95% of the time
- that's 180 to 190 days



Good attendance means...

being in school at least 95% of the time - 180 to 190 days

90% attendance = 19 days missed in a year

1 school year at **90%** attendance
= 4 weeks of lessons **missed!!!**

5 school years at **90%** attendance
= half a year of lessons **missed!!!**

Punctuality

Only 5
minutes
late!

5 minutes late every day (190 days)
= 3 days of missed learning opportunities

10 minutes late every day
= 6 days of missed opportunities

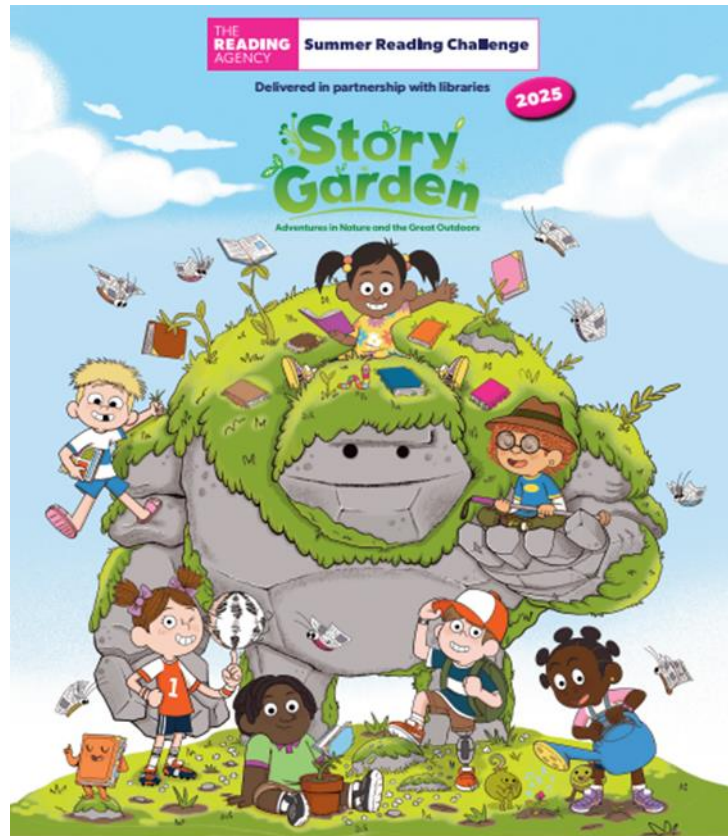
